Course Overview

This research course gives students a chance to present and discuss their ongoing projects with department faculty and other graduate students. Students in the second year of the Ph.D. program will give presentations on their ideas, and get early feedback on how to develop them. Students in the third and fourth years will work on improving their existing work as well as developing new ideas. Students in the final year of their program will have the opportunity to get feedback before their defense. Graduate students are also expected to be active participants and to give feedback during seminars.

Course Requirements

The sole requirement of this course is that students do at least one presentation during the semester. I have assigned presentation dates, and students are free to exchange them among one another. Students are required to email a copy of their slides to faculty members the day before their presentation.
